Free Food Cabinet on Daxue Road for Frontline Workers

There was a free food cabinet recently appearing on Daxue Road, Yangpu District that provided beverages, breads and biscuits, all free to take, for people who were still out there working amid the coronavirus outbreak, like volunteers, sanitation workers, police officers, security guards, package and food delivery workers.

About 3 pm on March 17 in the community of Chuangzhifang, where the cabinet was located, the reporter saw every now and then a delivery worker would come and take something from the cabinet. "My heart feels warm now. With orders increasing these days, we are busier and busier, and sometimes, don't even have time to eat. Some days I happen to deliver food around this area, and I would take some beverage and biscuit from the cabinet to eat," said one delivery worker, Xiao Chen.

Only half an hour later two thirds of food in the cabinet was already gone. Later then, a man with two cases of beverage came to restock the cabinet. He is George, the initiator of the free food cabinet, and an owner of a store on Daxue Road. "I like it here. I have feelings for this neighborhood. Having seen so many people who are risking their lives to keep our society going makes me want to do something for them," George told the reporter. Last February he had bought 50 kg of tomatoes and lots of milk and gave them out to volunteers, which earned him universally praises from other members of the community. But he still felt that there was a lot more that he could do. An idea occurred to him that he could put a cabinet on the Daxue Road with food and beverages inside for frontline workers to take. The cabinet must be near his studio so he would know anytime if the cabinet needed refill. Supported by the property management, a free food cabinet finally came out on the street on March 10.

Since then the free food cabinet had gone viral on the Internet, with



more and more citizens wanting to join this relay of kindness and love.

"A couple days ago, people from Lane 88 here told me that they

wanted to put together another cabinet for people in this city who were fighting the coronavirus. And I hope more and more business owners and citizens can join us in this good deed, and one day, the cabinet could be a new landmark on Daxue Road," said George.

Yangpu "Cloud Recruitment Service" Always Online

Under the epidemic, Yangpu promotes recruitment, expands employment service channels and innovates employment service models through the information network. In February, Yangpu held the first online job fair, focusing on the enterprises that guarantee epidemic control, operation of public utilities, people's living necessities, and involve in national economy and people's livelihood, including Hema Fresh, SF Express, etc, resulting in positive responses.

In March, Yangpu once again gathered forces, to organize the second comprehensive online job fair. According to statistics, among 65 participating enterprises, there were nearly 20 key enterprises in the district, including Shanghai Post & Telecommunication Design Consulting Research Institute Co., Ltd, Shanghai Honess Environmental Tech Corp and Shanghai Fudan Microelectronics Co., Ltd. and the overall enterprise participating ratio increased by 34% as compared with the first session; 254 posts and 2390 jobs were launched, of which the Internet and communications companies witnessed a large amount of recruitment, accounting for nearly 30%; the posts were dominated by sales and technology categories, including mid and high-end managerial positions.

It is noteworthy that this online job fair has significantly improved the effectiveness and integrity of job applicant's resume, as well as information interaction quality and human-job matching efficacy. "According to feedback from the companies joining in the previous online job fair, we have added an option of

'Submit with Only Basic Information' on the enterprise end, so that enterprises can choose whether to open based on the needs of post; if it is opened, job seekers only need basic information to submit; otherwise, job seekers will be requested to bear relatively complete resume information, including above 70% online resume completion rate or taking photo and uploading self—made resume before submission." District Human Resources and Social Security Bureau staff introduced.

In the meantime, the platform has added a real–time video interview function. During the video interview, information concerning job seeker's self–introduction, personal skills, job intent and the like will pop up on the computer interface, for recruiters to browse at any time. Video interviews no longer need to achieve by private WeChat or transferring to other platforms, and participants of this job fair are entitled to "one–stop" service on one platform.

The reporter have learned that apart from online job fair, a string of "Internet + " employment services are also continuously rolled out: create excellent "micro-sharing" workplace courses, gather outstanding career guidance resources at the municipal and district level, assist the job-hunters to raise job search skills and competitiveness, by means of online micro-lectures: provide "non-face-to-face" employment guidance service through online career guidance, online live-streaming salon, etc; and open up online employment service mailboxes, to serve online employment registration demands of individuals and enterprises in need of job search and recruitment.

One-stop Service Platform for Businesses Went Online

The Yangtze River Delta region is one of the divers for China's economic development, but there are administrative barriers between cities within this region due to different industry policies that prevent research and development funding from crossing the Yangtze River. In response to the problem, Yiquantong or One Pass, an integrated service platform established by the Association of the Yangtze River Delta Region "Crowd Entrepreneurship and Innovation" Model Bases that issues coupon to businesses, officially went online.

The coupon is a policy instru-

ment that is backed by government funding with a capital pool totaled at 20 million Yuan and enables cross-region procurement and will be implemented on a trial basis in four districts. The coupon is in digital form and can be applied for and used by businesses upon received and cashed by service suppliers. The four districts are Yangpu, Shanghai, Wujin, Changzhou, Nanhu, Jiaxing and the High-tech Industrial Development Zone, Hefei, qualified businesses within these districts can enjoy an annual credit line of up to 100,000 Yuan.

Yiquantong is operated by the National Eastern Tech-transfer Center, which provides one-stop

online services for businesses to apply for, use and cash the coupon. According to Shen Yuan, the director for operation of the coupon at the Center, the site also provides services like business profiling, organization profiling, online assessment, online transactions of products and services, and data mining and analvsis. Currently there has been 100 service organizations that plan to sign up to provide services in seven categories for businesses, including intellectual property, technology research and development, inspection and testing, technology transfer, technology and finance, personnel training, and entrepreneurship and innovation.

General Sport Venues Fully Opened in Shanghai

On March 17, Shanghai issued the "Version 2.0 of the Guidelines for Work Resumption in Sport Venues". According to the notice, general sport venues are fully opened, without need to file a record or register online. The number of people and project on site are no longer requested, but each venue may implement control as per the characteristics of project and site, in the moderate and orderly principle, which applies to indoor and outdoor sport stadiums, swimming pools, gyms and various sports

venues opened to the public, including public stadiums and business sport venues.

Over the past few days, Yangpu's fitness venues were galloping to resume work in an orderly manner. As soon as the gym was opened, many fitness enthusiasts could not wait to "sweat like rain". At 2:30 pm on March 16, after measuring temperature, checking gym appointment SMS, Shanghai QR Code, and disinfecting hands, Mr. Wang punched in at a gym near his home again.

Mr. Wang arrived at the Strength Zone, after warming up, performed squat rack, lat pull-down,

incline chest press and so forth, and he paused to rest, after exercising for more than ten minutes.

Apart from the Strength Zone, the Aerobic Zone in the gym is also as available as ever, and some exercisers consciously maintain a safe distance during exercise. The reporter noticed that in order to reduce the risks of cross-infection, many adjacent apparatuses in the gym were affixed with a suspension sign, requiring fitness personnel to use them at intervals. When it comes to the used apparatuses, cleaning staff disinfected them in time, to ensure cleaning per guest.
